Sunday, June 11

Day one kicks-off with a private jet flight from
Orange County to Monterey, where you will play a midday
round of golf at Spyglass Hill Golf Course featuring sandy
seaside dunes and majestic pines. After golf, check into
your deluxe accommodation at The Lodge at Pebble Beach,
then join the other players for a private cocktail reception,
putting contest, and welcome dinner with the annual
Folino Hall of Fame Award.

Monday, June 12

Day two begins with breakfast and consecutive morning tee times at The Links at Spanish Bay, a course boasting some of the best seaside views with rolling fairways and gorgeous dunescape. Monday is also host to our Father-Son Challenge, optional for those attending with family. Later that evening, enjoy the ever-popular chipping contest, cocktails, course stories, and a gourmet meal.

Tuesday, June 13

Day three starts with breakfast before your tee time at the world-famous Pebble Beach Golf Links, showcasing wide-open vistas, cliff side fairways, and sloping greens. After golf, soak in the views and enjoy lunch at The Lodge in our private dining room and balcony overlooking the 18th green. Before heading home, we wrap up this amazing trip with the Chairman's Cup Awards Ceremony. At departure, you will board a private jet to return to Orange County, just in time for a shower and dinner at home; the perfect end to the ultimate golf experience.





Spyglass Hill Golf Course

Themed after Robert Louis Stevenson's classic novel Treasure Island, Spyglass Hill Golf Course features the unique challenge of seaside greens mixed with narrow forest-lined fairways. Test your game on holes such as "Billy Bones", "Skeleton Island" and "Signal Hill"— the challenging 8th hole that many consider the most difficult par-4 under 400 yards in the world. Named one of the top public courses in America by Golf Digest, this legendary course is also rated as one of the toughest in the world from the championship tees. Legendary Los Angeles Times columnist Jim Murray reveled in its humanizing and sometimes humbling difficulty when he first saw Spyglass Hill during the 1967 Bing Crosby National Pro-Am: "It's a 300-acre unplayable lie... If it were human, Spyglass would have a knife in its teeth, a patch on its eye, a ring in its ear, tobacco in its beard and a blunderbuss in its hand... I love every unplayable inch of it. Every golf course in the world is Spyglass Hill to me."

Spanish Bay Golf Links

Tucked among the rolling sand dunes on the western tip of the Monterey Peninsula sits the Links at Spanish Bay. In 1987 Robert Trent Jones, Jr., Tom Watson, and Sandy Tatum teamed up to artfully craft a distinctly Scottish look. From the prevalent marine layer, to the white sand dunes, and manicured fairways, The Links at Spanish Bay evoke the original Scottish feel of the game. The majority of the front nine is played among sand dunes with striking views of the Pacific Ocean and a dramatic contrast to the green and gold hues that create an unforgettable backdrop. The Links at Spanish Bay is an elegant, challenging journey into golf's beginning that will leave you with a truly wonderful experience to remember.

Pebble Beach Golf Links

Pebble Beach Golf Links is one of the most famous courses in the world and has been home to some of the most legendary moments in golf history. The course hugs the rugged coastline and has wide open views of Carmel Bay, opening up to the Pacific Ocean on the south side of the Monterey Peninsula. Since 1919, golfers have enjoyed the course's unparalleled ocean views, stunning beauty and signature holes, including the par-3 7th, par-4 8th and the greatest finishing hole in golf, the par-5 18th. "It's one of the most intimidating golf courses I've ever played" said PGA Champion Rich Beems, "you get caught up in the views so easily, and all of a sudden you've got all of these difficult shots into greens that look like the size of dimes." Every golfer deserves to play Pebble Beach once in their life.










Chipping Contest
